Look, Cover, Write, Check: Look at the word, hide it, write it and check!

<u>Use your hand</u>: Write the word in the air. Try with your eyes shut.

<u>Use a friend, or parent:</u> Can they ask you to spell the words? Can they write it on your back and can you guess the word?

Handwrite: Use your best handwriting to write the word. Include the word in a sentence.

<u>Brain work:</u> Do you know what the word means? Use a dictionary if you're not sure of the meaning. Do you know parts of the word already? Break it down.

Sounds: Clap out the syllables. Say it out loud.
