Choose one of the animals and create a poster, or a non-chronological report about that animal. Look at the list below for ideas about what to include.



Success Criteria	Tick

I have drawn or written about its habitat (the type of place it lives. This could be coastal areas, ice, desert, rainforest).	
Challenge: Explain what can be done to help protect the animal and stop it from becoming extinct.
