Context

On Monday 22nd February 2021, The Prime Minister announced the government's roadmap to cautiously ease lockdown restrictions in England. This included a direction that from 29th March 2021 outdoor sports facilities and open-air swimming pools would be allowed to reopen.

Swimming lessons for PE

- The children will remain in their bubbles.
- Children must have their own swim hat and goggles.
- Teaching staff will also remain in their bubbles at poolside.
- Equipment used will be put to one side and will be sanitised ready for the next day.
- Hand sanitiser will be available at the pool entry and exit.

Volunteers

Volunteers may be invited to assist poolside, they will be asked to take a lateral flow test before coming on the school site.

Pool Hire

- There will be no splash sessions in 2021.
- Hire of the pool is possible for family groups, there will be a maximum of 2 sessions available per day.
- At the end of each hire session, whoever locks up must sanitise the equipment used and clean the toilet area and touch points.
- Should any member of the party hiring the pool have a positive COVID test within three days of use you must notify Long Primary School immediately by email enquiries@longsuttonprimary.co.uk.
- We reserve the right to cancel any bookings if the government guidelines for COVID-19 change.
- If cancellation is made due to government guidance a new booking may be made for a later date or a full refund can be given.
