Data since 2019

As you will be aware due to covid-19 there was no KS2 data in 2020 or 2021.

In 2022 we only had 9 Y6 pupils. When numbers are low (below 10) the data is not published. The children who were in that year group did well in their SATs papers and had made good progress in their time at Long Sutton.

The official data for 2023 has not been published yet but below is the school's version of it. This only includes attainment data not the progress data.

As a school we were very proud of the children, not only in how well they achieved but in how hard they worked and the mature, confident and relaxed way they tackled these tests. I am sure this will put them in good stead for the future.

Year 6 SATs data 2023 (19 children - 2 children were not able to do tests but are included in the percentages) 1 child equals 5.3%.
